The Summer School “Ceramic and Glass Science and Technology, application to bioceramics and bioglasses” was organised by ECerS (Francis Cambier, Véronique Huart, Jérôme Chevalier, Anne Leriche and Carmen Baudin) at the Instituto de Cerámica y Vidrio, CSIC in Madrid, Spain, from Wednesday 17 to Friday 19 June 2015.
