Vincenzo M. Sglavo is full professor of Materials Science and Technology at the Department of Industrial Engineering, University of Trento (Italy). He received the Laurea degree “cum laude” in Materials Engineering from the University of Trento (Italy) in 1988.

In 1989, he joined the Department of Materials Engineering, University of Trento, as Assistant Professor, and in 1999 became Associate Professor. Since May 1993 to August 1994, he worked as Post Doc Fellow at the Department of Materials Science and Engineering, The Pennsylvania State University (USA) where he went back as Adjunct Professor in 2001.

He has been appointed as full professor of Materials Science and Technology at the University of Trento in June 2019. He currently holds three courses on Ceramic Materials Engineering, Glass Engineering and Materials Science.

His research interests include electrical field-assisted sintering, materials for solid oxides fuel cells and electrolytic cells, fracture phenomena and strengthening methods in ceramics and glass.

Prof. Sglavo is author of more than 250 scientific papers, 15 book chapters and 13 patents. He has held more than 30 invited lectures and keynotes at international congresses. He has been responsible for more than 50 research projects funded by public institutions and private companies and foundations.

Prof. Sglavo is member of the Italian Ceramic Society.
